

8 Ways to Beautify Your Smile

IMPLANTS: Replace the roots of a tooth after it has been removed then act as if they are the root. Crowns and bridges, as well as dentures, can then be attached to the implant just as they would to a root.

TOOTH COLORED RESTORATIONS: Replacing old Amalgam (metal/silver - containing mercury) fillings with natural looking resin material which bonds to the remaining tooth structure creating a stronger restoration.

VENEERS: cover the front, and sometimes the sides of a tooth, to mask discoloration, correct moderately crooked teeth and improve the shape of teeth.

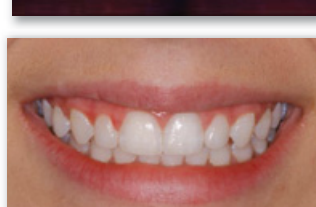
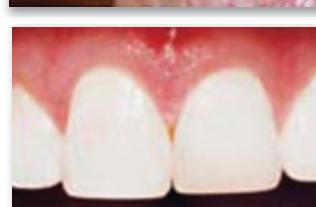
INVISALIGN/CROWNS: Correct crooked or crowded teeth, overbites, underbites. (Pictured) Crowns were prepared and placed on this patient after correcting tooth crowding and removing decay and restoring with resin restorations.

INVISALIGN/veneers: Correct crooked or crowded teeth, overbites, underbites. (Pictured) Veneers were prepared and placed on this patient after slightly correcting tooth spacing.

BRIDGE: Replace natural teeth by utilizing one or more of your natural teeth as a support "abutment" for a false tooth. The false tooth is typically located between the two abutment teeth.

BONDING: masks discolored teeth and can camouflage other flaws such as small fractures or straightening slightly crooked teeth.

WHITENING: Lightens the color of teeth that have darkened due to age, coffee, tea, wine, smoking and medications. Whitening can be done either in office or in the comfort of your own home.

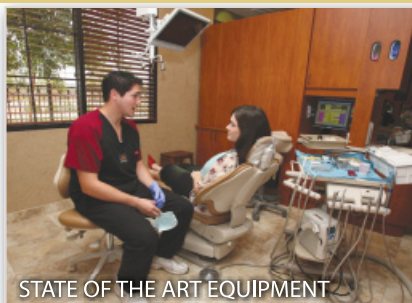
