

Composite (white) Restoration Agreement Form

Most dental insurance plans do not allow full benefits for composites (white fillings) performed on posterior teeth (back molars). The plan benefit will customarily pay for less expensive treatment- AMALGAM (silver/mercury based restoration). For the best of our patients, we recommend and **we place only composite-based ("white") fillings**. The difference is usually \$50-\$100 per filling but may be more depending on the insurance plan you have selected and the patient is responsible for the difference in cost. Please ask our front desk or doctor if you need more information about composite-based "white" fillings.

The insurance co-payment you pay at the office will cover part of your composite filling. When we receive the insurance payment and you receive your Explanation of Benefits you will see what amount the provider may bill you. This is the difference between a white filling and a silver/mercury based filling.
