

# Pharmacy Protocol

☑ Our pharmacy will dispense the following scripts:

- Pre-med amoxicillin 500mg (#4) stat
- Pre-med clindamycin 150 mg (#4) stat
- Amoxicillin 500mg #21 – 1 tid x 7
- Clindamycin 150mg #42 – 2 tid x 7
- Ibuprofen 400mg #28 – 1-2 q4-6h prn pain
- Acetaminophen 500mg #28 – 1-2 q4-6h prn pain

Pharmacy will have 6 sets of record-keeping sheets for each of the scripts we listed above

- (i.e. 1 set will say pre-med amoxicillin on the top)
- Each of these sheets will have columns which list the Rx number, patients name Dr's name, patient's signature and the dispensing doctor's signature.
- An ambassador must escort a patient to the pharmacy department and hand the tx sheet with the script to a volunteer.
- The volunteer will write the appropriate information in the first 2 columns of the record keeping sheets and ask a dentist to counsel the patient.
- The volunteer will also write the same information on a label and adhere it to the appropriate vial.
- The dentist will dispense the prescribed med(s) to the patient and sign the record-keeping form.
- Each of the above 8 prescriptions will have a special marking on the top of its vial and will be stored in separate boxes.
- Labels will be pre-printed and lines left for the Rx#, date, patient's name, DOB, address, phone number, and prescribing doctor.
