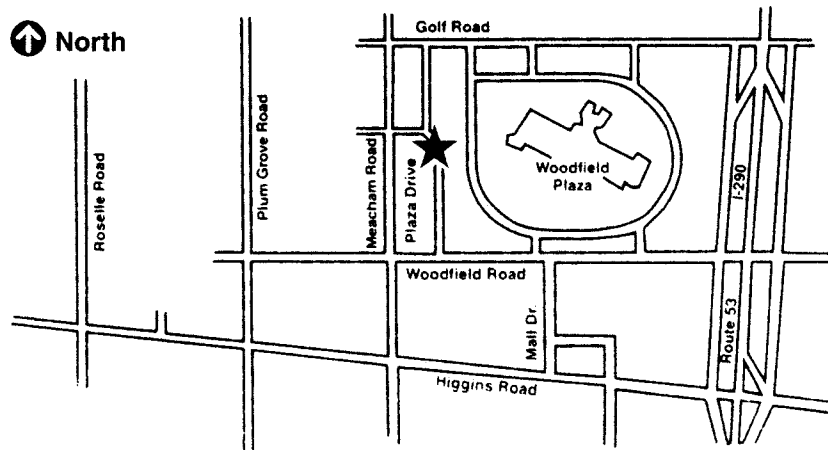
PATIENT'S INSTRUCTIONS ON BACK - PLEASE REVIEW

Preparation for Oral Surgery

1. If you are unable to keep your appointment for any reason, please notify the office at least 24 hours prior to your appointment.
2. If you have a history of any of the following medical conditions please inform the receptionist at the time you call for an appointment: Diabetes, Heart Disease or any other medical problem.
3. **PAYMENT:** We do accept personal checks, Visa, MasterCard, American Express and Discover. We also offer a no-interest payment plan through Care Credit. As a courtesy, we will file claims to your insurance company. Please bring your medical AND dental insurance cards with you at the time of your appointment, so that we can try to maximize your benefit reimbursement for you.

Special Instructions for General Anesthesia or Sedation

1. Do not eat or drink anything (including water and coffee) from midnight the night before surgery. If you need to take medication, use as little water as possible.
2. You must make arrangements for an adult to drive you home. This person must be in the office with you.
3. Please do not bring any children with you. Arrange for someone to care for them on the day of surgery.
4. Do not drive or operate dangerous machinery until the day following surgery.
5. Please wear clothing that is not tight on your arms, so we may start an I.V. and place monitors. Short sleeves are preferred so that monitors can be placed.
