This letter to each of you is a report that may be of interest as I am under your care..

On November 21, 2007, during a complete dental check-up, Dr. Pessera noticed a growth on my uvula. He suggested I see an oral surgeon as soon as possible. I told him that we would be leaving Michigan for Florida the next week and did not think it would be possible to see a surgeon in that short time. However I would follow up when I arrived in Florida.

We arrived and the first morning here, Friday 11/30/07, I contacted an oral surgeon, but was told that the growth was too far down the throat and I should see an EENT. They referred me to a EENT surgeon and I was able to see the doctor that same day. He confirmed Dr. Pessera's findings, and suggested surgery, which was scheduled for Wednesday. 12-05-07.

Today, recovering from the surgery, I received a report on the biopsy, which was "benign squamous cell papiloma of uvula". I am grateful to my Dentist, Dr. Pessera for his great care, and to the Lord for the calmness during this time because it has been a whirlwind three weeks, and it's now over.
