



Patients With Dental Insurance

HMO Type Insurance:

We encourage all of our patients to familiarize themselves with their dental plan. Your insurance company is responsible for sending you a book with your specific fee schedule so that you are aware of all your co-payments. No claims are filed to your insurance company and you are responsible for any co-payment you may have when the service is rendered.

PPO Type Insurance:

PLEASE UNDERSTAND that we file dental insurance as a courtesy to our patients. We do not have a contract with your insurance company, only you do. We are not responsible for how your insurance company handles its claims or for what benefits they pay on a claim. We can only assist you in estimating your portion of the cost of treatment. We at no time guarantee what your insurance will or will not do with each claim. Dental insurance is a contract between your employer and a dental insurance company. The benefits you receive are based on the terms of the contract that was negotiated between your employer and the dental insurance company.

Your insurance company is required to pay each claim within 30-45 days of receipt. We file all insurance electronically, so your insurance company will receive each claim within days of the treatment. You are responsible for any balance on your account after 45 days, whether insurance has paid or not.
